He passed the EQE as an Examiner and joined leading Spanish private practice ZBM Patents in Barcelona shortly after in 2008. He became a partner of ZBM three years later. He received a Diploma on Patent Litigation in Europe from CEIPI in 2011. He is active as CEIPI tutor, lectures regularly in Spain and has been a speaker of EPO Guidelines2Day.

Kemal Bengi received his M.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Erlangen, Germany, in 1997 and his Ph.D. degree in Telecommunications from the Vienna University of Technology, Austria, in 2001, with distinctions. Afterwards, he served in academia as researcher and lecturer. He has authored several conference and journal papers in the field of access protocols for optical networks as well as a book entitled "Optical Packet Access Protocols for WDM Networks" edited by Springer.

From September 2002 to January 2012 he worked as a Patent Examiner in the field of telecommunication networks at the European Patent Office (EPO) in Munich. In February 2012 he was appointed Technical Member of the Board of Appeal 3.5.05 dealing with appeal cases in the fields of telecommunication and computer networks as well as mobile terminals. He regularly gives talks on the patentability of computer-implemented inventions, in particular graphical user interfaces.
