Guy Patton is a technically qualified member of a board of appeal, dealing with various technical fields such as packing, conveying, robots, hand tools, paper making. He is a mechanical engineer (Ecole Nationale Supérieure d'Arts et Métiers, France) and has a Master of Science in materials engineering (Virginia Tech, USA) as well as a PhD in metallurgy

(Institut National des Sciences Appliquées, France). Before joining the EPO he worked several years in a metallurgy Group managing research projects as well as production lines dedicated to research.
